



**NOTICE OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Irvine on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the election of the following officers:

Mayor (At-Large):	Full term of two (2) years
One (1) Member of the City Council - District 1:	Full term of four (4) years
One (1) Member of the City Council - District 5:	Full term of four (4) years
One (1) Member of the City Council - District 6:	Full term of four (4) years

The nomination period for these offices begins on Monday, July 13, 2026, and closes at 5 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2026. Nomination papers are only available from the City Clerk during regular office hours by appointment (Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Friday 8 am to 5 pm). The City Clerk's Office is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of City Hall, 1 Civic Center Plaza, Irvine, CA, 92606. To schedule an appointment, please call the City Clerk's Office at 949-724-6205.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by August 7, 2026, during normal business hours, as posted, the voters shall have until the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election, Wednesday, August 12, 2026, by close of business (5:30 p.m.), to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected (i.e. Council District No. 6).

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls/vote centers will be open between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.
