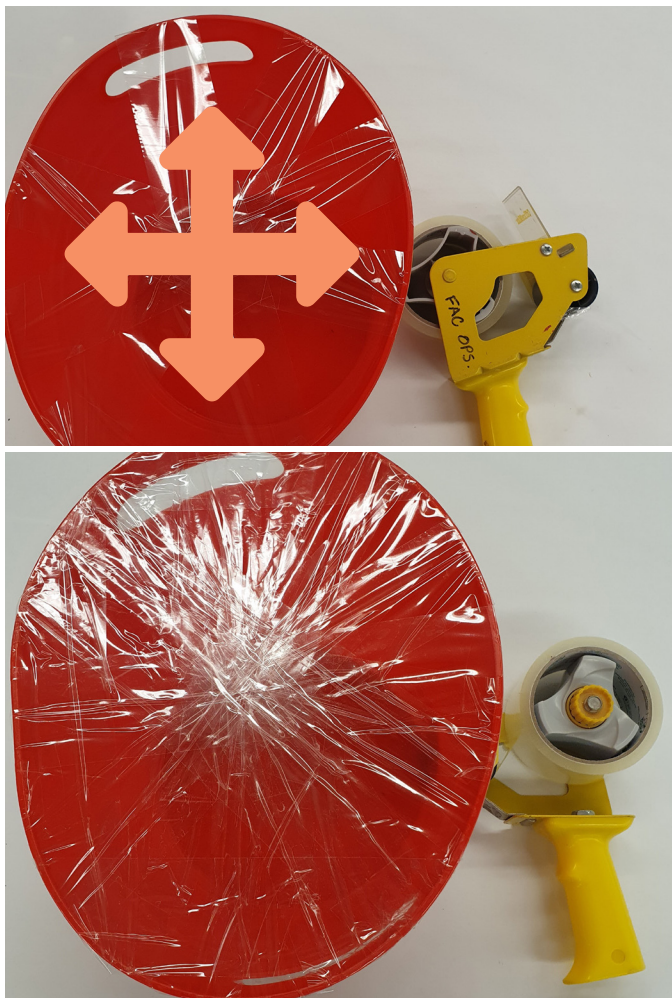
Make your own all-in-one instrument to bring the sounds and spirit of the Irvine Global Village Festival to life. You can bring it to play along with the Mariachi Divas at the concert on Saturday, October 10, or create your own concert right at home.

Supplies needed:

- **Pencil**
- **Eraser**
- **A medium-sized vessel**
Example: beach bucket, coffee tin, soup can, cardboard box
- **Clear packing tape**
- **Construction paper**
(approximately 9" x 12");
various colors
- **Colored Sharpies or markers**
- **Yarn;** various colors
- **Elmer's Glue or hot glue gun**
(with parental guidance)
- **Scissors**
- **Things that make noise**
Example: macaroni, rice, beads,
marbles
- **Items to embellish**
Example: buttons, jewels, stickers,
macaroni



Step 1



- Add rice, beads, macaroni, or any small items that will make noise inside your drum.
- Using packing tape, tape the opening of your vessel in a crisscross formation.
- Keep the tape tight and full of resistance so the sound is able to bounce off the drum when you hit it.
- Do this until the top of the drum is covered and there are no holes.

Step 2



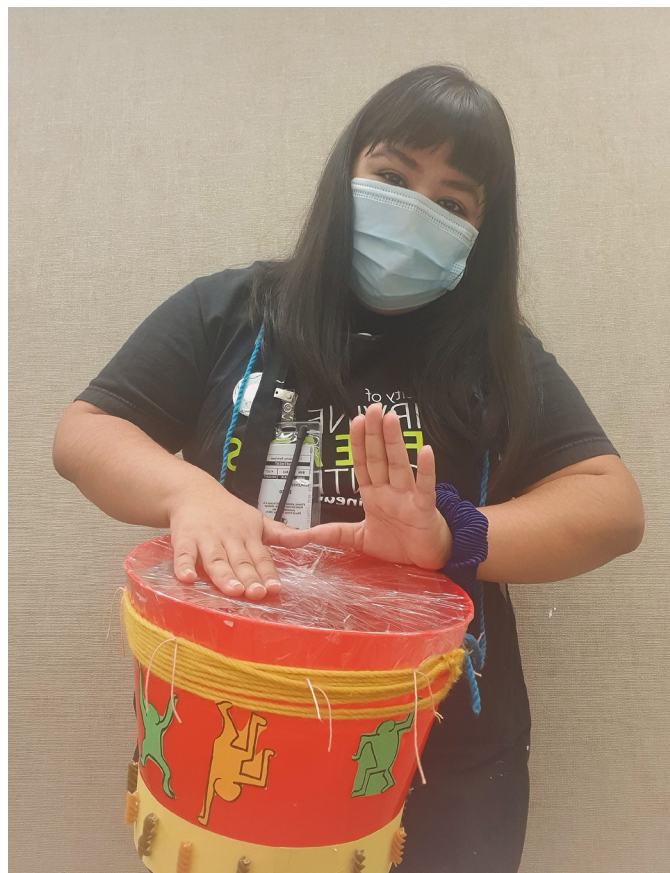
- Using a pencil, draw images, patterns, shapes, or dancing figures on your choice of construction paper.
- Once satisfied, go over it with a Sharpie or markers to give it color.
- Cut out your image and glue onto the side of your drum.
- You can also glue on macaroni, beads, buttons, or jewels to create a border.

Step 3



- Begin wrapping yarn around the drum until you create a thick band at the top and cover the edges and ends of the packing tape.
- Tie a knot so the yarn doesn't unravel, or you can glue the end of the yarn with a hot glue gun.
- Grab a different piece of yarn and tie knots on opposite sides; this will be where your drum hangs.
- Make sure the knots are tight and the yarn is long enough to hang from your neck.

Step 4



- Enjoy your drum!
