Yale Avenue Enhancement Project

The City of Irvine is leading the Yale Avenue Enhancement project to enhance safety, accessibility and mobility along Yale Avenue north of the I-405 Freeway. The project will evaluate opportunities to implement potential improvements such as protected bikeways or separated bikeways, pedestrian crossings, traffic control devices, protected intersections, and other features that support all users.

Project Benefits

- Enhanced safety and connectivity for people who walk, bike, drive and take transit.
- New and improved bike lanes to support safe, active transportation and improve network connections.
- Improved trail connections to increase recreation opportunities.
- Upgraded pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure to separate bicyclists from pedestrians.
- Expanded village connectivity for safe, convenient, sustainable travel within or between the villages.

Project Timeline

Spring 2026

Develop preliminary alternative designs

Fall 2026

Gather community inputs on alternatives

Winter 2026/2027

Select preferred alternative and begin environmental clearance

Summer 2027

Complete preliminary study and environmental clearance

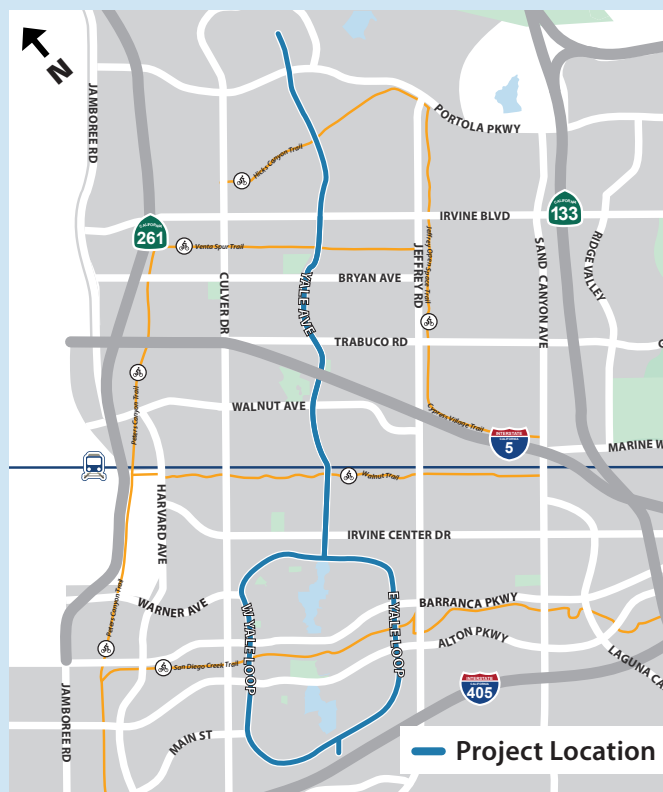
Fall 2027
